Adam May had a long game against his opponent where he ended up being 2 pawns down in a queen and bishop endgame. He did have a chance to win one pawn back but after missing that he had no way back and eventually resigned.

Allan Pleasants had a nice game against his opponent. They ended up getting into a double rook and pawn endgame where Allan had got one of his pawns one square away from queening. A draw was agreed as Allan could not see how to progress the position. Unfortunately he missed a combination that would have won the final position.

A game we can happily forget unfortunately.
